▪ Sunscreen (SPF 30 +)	▪ Mirror *
▪ Hat / bandanna	▪ Watch *
▪ Breakfast snack & Lunch	▪ Disposable camera *

▪ Sleeping Bag or Blanket/Sheet	▪ Headlamp
▪ Sweatshirt or Fleece	➤ Extra Batteries
▪ Lightweight Jacket	▪ Pocket Knife *
▪ River Shoes (closed toe)	▪ Clothes line (25')
➤ Or old sneakers / no water socks	▪ Clothes pins (4-6)
▪ Wool Socks (2 pr)	<b>Camp Trunk (Clothing Sets in bags)</b>
▪ Long Pants (1 pr) (not jeans)	▪ Underwear (7 pr)
▪ Long Sleeved Shirt	▪ Socks (7 – 10 pr)
▪ Scout Handbook	▪ T-shirts (7 ea)
▪ Merit Badge Handbooks	➤ Scout Class B or plain colored
▪ Washcloth & towel	➤ 3 T29 shirts provided by troop
▪ Metal Coat Hanger	▪ Shorts (4-7 pr)
▪ Insect Netting	<b>Packed Separately</b>
▪ Spiral notebook, pens/pencil	▪ Insect Poles
▪ Camp Pillow	▪ Foam Sleep Pad
▪ Handkerchiefs	▪ Carpet / tarp for tent *
▪ Bathing suit (second)	<b>Turned in to Troop</b>
▪ Swim Towels (second)	▪ Spending Money *
▪ Mess Kit	▪ Medications (OTC and Script)

Essentially, any electronic device

Food, Snacks, or Candy of ANY kind.

Fireworks, caps or cap guns

Fixed blades or flip open knives

Firearms or air guns

Family heirlooms or anything you would be sorry to  
potentially lose.

Fighting / bullying or unscoutlike behavior
